Re: Corrosion Protection by Marine Protection Systems (MPS) www.marineprotectionssystem.com.au

I have had the full suite of MPS corrosion protection products on my power catamaran for 4 years. I was introduced to the products with the view of selling them through my Gold Coast City Marine engineering businesses but I wanted to trial their performance first.



I had MPS install their Electrolysis Blocker (galvanic Isolator) to stop stray earth current from the marina, Shaft Grounding Straps on each shaft to eliminate shaft anodes and a Maddox composite alloy anode on each hull. The bonding system was also inspected and upgraded where necessary. Previous to using MPS products I was changing 14 plain zinc anodes every year and losing up to 200RPM due to growth and weed. I was also experiencing paint blasting around skin fittings, rudders and docking strips.

After 4 years now I am on my second set of Maddox anodes and only fit 4 pieces instead of 14. My shaft straps are still operating as new and there is no paint blasting whatsoever. Best of all, MPS have reduced the growth to a small amount of loose slime and I do not lose any RPM during the year, even after sitting idle for a few months over the off season.

I can say after thoroughly testing the MPS products first hand that they deliver the results they claim and have saved me time and money in maintenance and repair. MPS have also eliminated any worry about the effects of corrosion with my vessel.

I see so many boat owners take the same traditional action every year with limited success. I now have no problem recommending, selling and installing MPS corrosion protection.
